Ayşen Güven works as Director Education at the British Council in Türkiye, where she provides strategic leadership across the Education, English, and Science programmes.

She has led large-scale national initiatives aimed at enhancing teaching and learning in higher education, working in close collaboration with the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) and the Higher Education Quality Council (YÖKAK). Over the past five years, she has directed English Together, a nationwide English language teaching initiative delivered in partnership with the Ministry of National Education and the Sabancı Foundation, which has reached more than 30,000 English language teachers across Türkiye.
