Didem Mutçalıoğlu is a founding member and the current Chair of the Association for Language Education, Evaluation, and Accreditation (DEDAK). She also serves as a Commissioner at the Commission on English Language Program Accreditation (CEA).

From 2009 to 2024, Didem served as Director of the English Language Programs at İstanbul Bilgi University, successfully leading two comprehensive CEA self-study processes. This resulted in an initial five-year accreditation, followed by a ten-year re-accreditation. Additionally, in 2003, she led the EAQUALS accreditation process for the university's Undergraduate Academic English Program, achieving initial accreditation and subsequent re-accreditation.

In 2017, she completed the WSCUC Assessment Leadership Academy, a one-year program designed to develop leadership skills in accreditation, academic program learning outcome assessment, and academic program review. As the Accreditation Liaison Officer, she spearheaded istanbul Bilgi University's institutional accreditation initiative with the WASC Senior College and University Commission (WSCUC). This resulted in a six-year institutional accreditation—the first international institutional accreditation granted to a higher education institution in Türkiye.

She actively serves as a peer reviewer for DEDAK and CEA accreditations and is one of the trainers delivering DEDAK reviewer trainings. She holds BA and MA degrees in English Language Teaching and is currently pursuing her doctorate in higher education at the University of Liverpool.
